A high front-facing gabled roof, featuring small shed-style dormers on the sides, caps the 1½ sotry house shown below. The exterior is now covered with asbestos shingles. A pair of casement windows, flanked with shutters, is centered in the front gable facade. A recessed porch occupies the eastern half of the first floor and is supported by round wooden columns. A large stationary plate glass window occupies the center of the west half of the front facade. Double-hung windows are used throughout the rest of the house with the exception of two sets of small casement windows. A shed-style back porch, located at the rear has been enclosed. A picket fence, with an arched arbor over the entry, encloses the front yard.
