





The bands that the village has brought in are nothing short of amazing. Some cover, some original and most tribute... Close your eyes and they sound just like the real bands. I've become extremely proud of the entertainment we offer (free of charge) and when friends and family come and visit, the concerts are a standard item on our weekend agenda. Many come up now and look forward to the evenings in the village even more than the lake time during the days. I love the music, I like to dance, and I enjoy the camaraderie with family and friends. Economic Impact As a small business owner, I recognize how important one event can mean to a single day of business. So, for a whole season of events to be at jeopardy, the impact to our local businesses could be devastating. I've had an opportunity to work directly with some of the small business owners in the village and over the years they have candidly shared with me their sales numbers. I've seen how the sales have increased as the concerts became better organized and more popular bands were attracted. Alternatively, I've also seen the change in figures when there have been challenges in marketing or when popular bands were dropped from the season roster. The concert series brings visitors from down the hill. They stay in our hotels and rentals. They eat in our restaurants. They shop in our stores. They help keep our businesses healthy and put dollars in the bank so they can survive through the winter season. Plain and simple, without the concert series, many of our local businesses simply won't be able to survive. This worries me incredibly. Lastly, I can't tell you how many times I've been sitting on the grass, listening to the music, and struck up conversation with a visitor to the mountains. Invariably the conversation turns to "What's it like to live up here?", and then to real estate and "How much are places?" and "Do you know a realtor?" I wish I had the actual statistics for how many homes have been sold as a result of someone coming up to the community to see the concerts, I'm sure it's worth noting. Safety I imagine I've personally have attended over 80% of the concerts that have been shown in the last 10 years. 
