This correspondence is intended to serve notice in accordance with the requirements set forth in Public Resources Code, Section 2774(d)(2). San Bernardino County is set to approve a request to amend Reclamation Plan 90M-07. The amendment will modify the configuration of the existing mine quarry and prolong the completion date for reclamation. The subject mine site is currently being operated by Brubaker Mann, Inc. on patented lands located between Barstow and Yermo, California. The Public Hearing is anticipated to take place on June 5, 2014, or shortly thereafter, and decided upon by the Planning Commission. A copy of the decision will be provided to the Office of Mine Reclamation (OMR) thereafter.

County staff has considered the comments offered by OMR in the letters dated August 6, 2013 and April 10, 2014 and believe that the concerns raised have already been addressed and the County will incorporate OMR's comments as requirements before the final Reclamation Plan becomes effective.
