APPLICANT: Treh Partners, LLC

COMMUNITY: Redlands/3rd Supervisorial District

LOCATION: North of San Bernardino Avenue, west of the 210 Freeway, south of East Pioneer Avenue, and east of Alabama Street

PROJECT NO: P201300535

PROPOSAL: A) General Plan Amendment to change the official County land use district from East Valley/General Commercial (EV/CG) to East Valley/Special Development (EV/SD) for Parcels 0292-072-04, 10 and 11, and to assign a land use designation of EV/SD for Parcels 0292-072-07 and 12 currently within the City of Redlands.

B) Conditional Use Permit for the construction of a 777,620 square foot industrial building with 30,000 square feet of office area to be used as a high cube warehouse distribution facility, and the relocation of an existing telecommunications tower on 35.98 acres.

C) Tentative Parcel Map 19500 for a one lot subdivision.
