- Correction on condition #97 to change "Road Dedication. A 22-foot grant of easement is required to provide a half width right-of-way of 52 feet." to read "Road Dedication. A 12-foot grant of easement is required to provide a half width right-of-way of 52 feet." (on Indian Trail)
- Addition of a condition of approval to require a construction management plan prior to the issuance of a grading permit.
- Addition of a condition of approval to require an official disclosure to future property owners of the activities and operations that take place at the Twentynine Palms Marine Base.
