Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

Powerflex (Project Applicant) requests approval of a Conditional Use Permit for the development of a 5 megawatt alternating current (MW AC) ground-mounted solar system on approximately 29 acres of vacant land and 0.6-mile of a new interconnection line for the purpose of power generation for onsite consumption by the OMYA mining plant, located at 7225 Crystal Creek Road in the unincorporated community of Lucerne Valley.
