The applicant has requested approval of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP2022-00081) for a proposed 10 megawatt (MW) photovoltaic solar energy-generating facility known as the Glacier Power and Gas Solar Project. The Project Site consists of one parcel of approximately 24.12 acres, located in the Community of Yermo, in unincorporated San Bernardino County. The Project Site is located in the west portion of the Mojave Desert.
